Narrow win for EB

East Bengal rode on substitute Ryuji Sueoka's strike to scrape past Semen Padang of Indonesia 1-0 in their home-leg of AFC Cup quarterfinals in Kolkata on Tuesday. Sueoka, who replaced Rebangmei Vashum in the 55th minute, sent a curling shot from the edge of the box into the Padang net in the 71st minute. East Bengal will face the Indonesian outfit in the return-leg of the quarterfinals at the Padang on September 24.

Cilic to appeal against ban: Former world No. 9 Marin Cilic has said he would be appealing a nine-month doping ban imposed on him after he tested positive for the banned stimulant nikethamide. "I will be appealing that decision to the Court of Arbitration for Sport," Cilic said.

Gujrathi, Sethuraman jump to joint second: Indian Grandmasters Vidit Gujrathi and SP Sethuraman registered victories to jump to joint

second spot on 3.5 points at the end of the fourth round of World Junior Chess Championship in Kocaeli, Turkey. While Gujrathi downed Jurab Javakhadze of Georgia, Sethuraman got the better of Vahe Bagdasaryan of Armenia in their fourth round encounters.

Pakistan out of Commonwealth Games hockey: Pakistan were eliminated from the hockey event at next year's Commonwealth Games after failing to enter the event by the deadline due to an internal dispute. The latest setback comes barely a month after the team failed to qualify for next year's World Cup.
